## EMV-Certified Payment Terminal — *Now Generally Available!*

We're excited to announce that Blackbaud's **EMV-Certified Payment Terminal** solution is now available in **Blackbaud Altru** to all organizations who process payments through **Blackbaud Merchant Services**.



Payment Terminal helps protect against costly credit card fraud through the use of EMV-certified card readers that offer End-to-end Encryption (E2EE). The devices support chip cards and contactless methods such as digital wallets, and provide additional security for card-present transactions.

To get started with Payment Terminal:
